Submission Form

The NYO Scholarship started in 2020 as support to senior high school students and athletes pursuing higher education. For the fourth consecutive year, this support is once again available for interested students. This year, the scholarship has increased: **TWO** \$1500 academic scholarships will be awarded to one male and one female senior athlete for post-secondary education. **High school seniors** across Alaska actively participating with a Native Youth Olympics team and who are planning to attend a vocational school or college are encouraged to apply.

Winners will be chosen by the Education Scholarship Committee and announced on Friday, April 21st during the Senior NYO Games Celebration of Graduates and on the [NYO Games Alaska Facebook](#) page. Applicants do not need to be present at the Senior NYO Games, April 20-22, to win.

Eligibility

- Must be an Alaska resident
- Must be a 2022-2023 high school senior planning to graduate with a high school diploma or GED
- Must be planning to attend a vocational school or college as a full-time student in fall 2023. Proof of enrollment required (e.g., letter of acceptance or class schedule)
- Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Must be an active participant with an NYO team within your community. Proof of participation required (signed letter from program coordinator)
- Preference will be given to students with more than one year of participation in NYO

How to Participate:

1. Fill out the form on the second page
2. Provide a video OR written statement on the theme “How NYO has impacted my life”
3. Provide proof of enrollment to a vocational school or college as a full-time student (letter of acceptance or class schedule)
4. Provide proof of active participation with an NYO team (signed letter from program coordinator)
